This setting is particularly important as it dictates how health services operate and, unfortunately, it means we are still not permitted to have our volunteers working in the community. Vaccination and visitors to aged care facilities

We strongly encourage all visitors to our aged care facilities to be vaccinated against COVID-19. As the aged care provider, we reserve the right to put extra safety measures in place if you are not vaccinated, such as virtual visits etc. We must protect our residents and staff, so please respect this decision.

Please note: Visitors are not permitted to visit inside our residential aged care facilities (in line with the current community setting of visitors in your own home). Outdoor visits will be permitted for compassionate and end of life reasons only, for up to two people at a time from the same household. Families are asked to phone the facility to discuss their visiting requests. Virtual and window visits are encouraged. Residents are permitted to leave the facility if they wish.

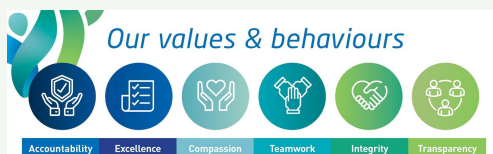
